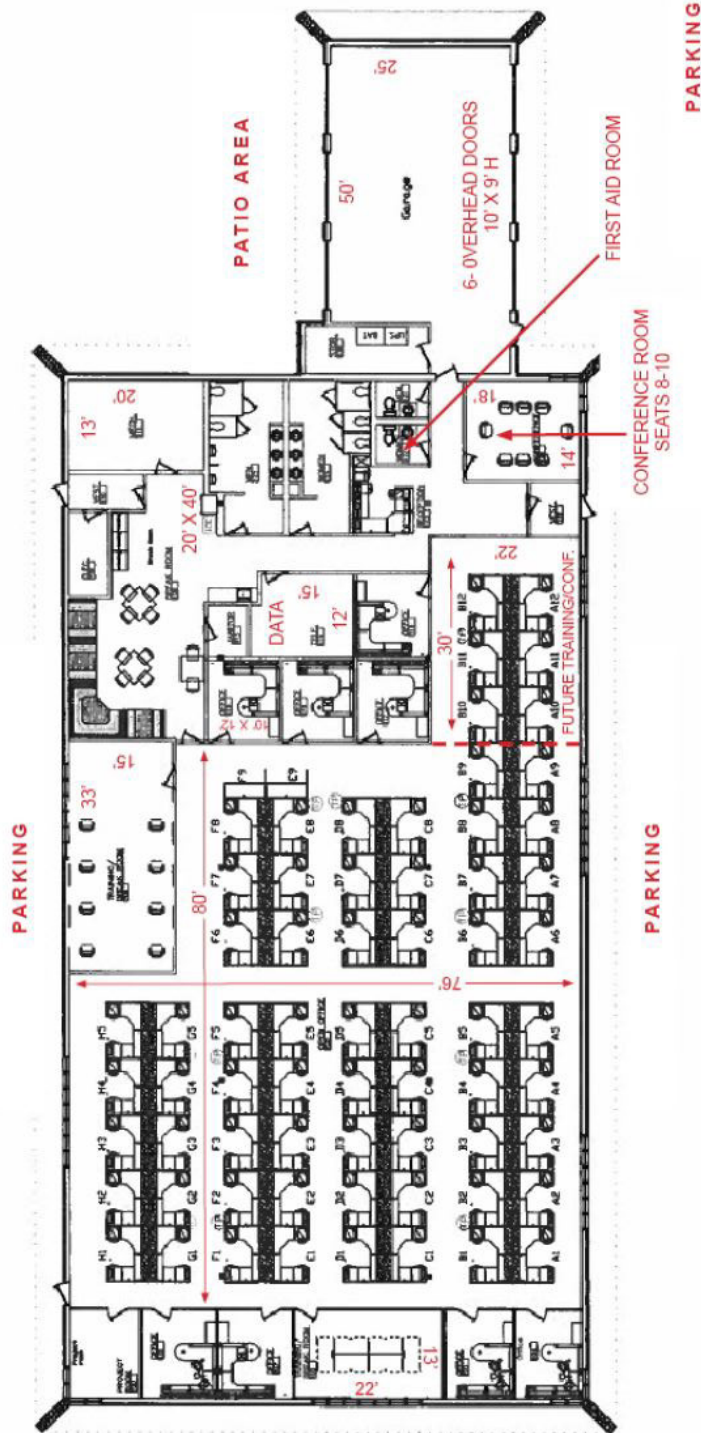

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## STATE OF WISCONSIN BROKER DISCLOSURE



Wisconsin law requires all real estate licensees to give the following information about brokerage services to prospective customers.
