

SUPERB PROXIMITY

Centrally located in the East Bay – amidst excellent transportation network and 2 BART stations. Coca-Cola's Bottling Plant is located across from the property. Ghirardelli chocolates are made in San Leandro. Other companies in the vicinity include: Drake's Brewing, Pavel's Yogurt, Georgia-Pacific Corp, Otis Spunkmeyer, 21st Amendment Brewery, San Francisco Hat Company, and Galant Food Company. Nearby companies also manufacture/fabricate steel, plastic, diesel exhausts, desalination and computer control systems.

- 2.5 miles from Downtown San Leandro
- 6 miles to I-92 (San Mateo-Hayward Bridge) linking the East Bay with SF Peninsula

SAN LEANDRO ECONOMY, DEVELOPMENT, INNOVATION

The City of San Leandro is a thriving, dynamic community, which includes many new projects, businesses and amenities. It is home to the world's largest 3D printing coalition at The Gate 501 (a former auto factory) and Ghirardelli Chocolate has been headquartered in San Leandro since the early 1960s. Other highlights:

- Well-served by public transportation and the central BART station
- Adjacent to BART, the new Tech Campus has brought a wave of business activity, employees, and innovation to the
 city. The 55-foot steel sculpture, Truth is Beauty (by artist Marco Cochrane) symbolizes the transformation taking
 place in Downtown San Leandro as a center of technology, innovation and human potential
- The first of three buildings at the Tech Campus has been leased by OSIsoft (a computer software company)
- A public/private partnership named "Lit San Leandro" offers state-of-the-art fiber optic internet connections to businesses in the fiber loop
- The first official coworking space in Downtown San Leandro, Station SL, recently opened at 1455 Hays Street, just 2 blocks from BART
- 553,200 square feet of Class-A industrial space for high-tech manufacturing, assembly, and distribution is being developed as the San Leandro Business Center
- Vibrant downtown area with craft breweries, new restaurants, weekly farmer's market, monthly "Truth Thursdays" (community food truck event with live music), annual Cherry Festival (in its 109th year) all bring new vitality to the city











FREE SHUTTLE



The LINKS shuttle serves businesses in West San Leandro by providing a free transportation link between places of employment and the Downtown San Leandro BART Station – 2 buses run every 20 minutes during morning and evening commute hours. LINKS receives overwhelmingly positive feedback from riders and ridership has grown over the past decade. LINKS is funded through a variety of sources including regional grants. A significant portion of the funding comes from a Business Improvement District (BID) that is formed by businesses within 1/4 mile of the shuttle route.


