


BACK BAY is the main shopping and dining destination in Boston. It is home to over 450 shops, 200 restaurants, and over 6,000 rooms in over 20 hotels. It is the second largest office market in Boston with over 16 million square feet of space. Copley Square sits between the 1800s landmarks Boston Public Library and Trinity Church. Mansions dot the neighborhood's tree-lined streets, many on Paris-inspired Commonwealth Avenue. Over 50 million people visit the Back Bay each year spending \$5M per day.

















NEWBURY STREET is the only true high-street retail corridor in Boston. On either side of its eight blocks, it is flanked with a mix of designer boutiques, fashion chains, art galleries, and patio cafes. Most of these are set in elegant brick townhouses that have been renovated to accommodate retail on many levels. There are coffee shops, trendy cafes and an assortment of restaurants to suit all tastes.


