



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Prime Location

The property is in the City of Lake Elsinore, Surrounded by expanding development. Key features are The Lake Elsinore Storm baseball stadium, the Lake Elsinore lake, The Shores at Lake Elsinore and the master-planned community "Summerly". Summerly, which is currently in the late stages of development, includes over 1,500 single-family homes, a golf course and club house with restaurant. Homes in Lake Elsinore are currently selling in the neighborhoods of "Northstar" by RichmondAmerica, "Meridian" by Meritage Home, "Daybreak" by McMillan Communities and "Sunrise Springs" by Ryland Homes while the neighborhood "Sunset Hill" by Beazer Homes has sold out. Lake Elsinore was the fastest growing city in the state of California in 2013 and was recently ranked the fifth best city for home ownership in California by NerdWallet.

Local Amenities

The property is located near the Lake Elsinore Retail Outlets comprised of nearly 100 stores offering top brandname merchandise at extraordinary values. Locals and tourists also frequent the city's historic downtown district lined with numerous antique shops, a museum, cozy restaurants and quaint vendors. The Lake Elsinore Diamond is home of the Lake Elsinore Storm AAA Professional Baseball club, an affiliate of the San Diego Padres which hosts minor league baseball games.
