



SOUTH ELEVATION




WEST ELEVATION

Note: This 1880's Queen Anne was converted from residential to office/ service use and may be converted back to residential use.








- Elburn, a far western Chicago suburb, is a village in Kane County, Illinois, situated 46 miles due west of the Chicago Loop.
