Transportation Information:

Renaissance Park/Industrial Park Properties are accessed from M-55 which is a state trunkline highway in the northern part of the State of Michigan. M-55 is one of only three state highways that extend across the Lower Peninsula from Lake Huron to Lake Michigan. The intersection of M-55 and US 31 is a mere two miles away. US-31 it is a state trunkline highway that runs from the Indiana—Michigan state line at Bertrand Township north to its terminus at Interstate 75 (I-75) south of Mackinaw City. Manistee Blacker Airport is located 4 miles from the Park.

Manistee Blacker Airport is the most affordable and convenient option between Northern Michigan and Chicago. Servicing Manistee, Cadillac, Ludington, Frankfort and Traverse City and the Greater Chicago Region, this service is a customer favorite with a 95%+ customer referral rate!

Manistee is blessed with a deep draft commercial harbor. Bulk freighters navigate the harbor mouth and river channel during the shipping season delivering coal and other products to the industries around Manistee Lake and is five miles from the site. Genesee and Wyoming, Midwest Regional Railroads operates the rail and switchyards around Manistee Lake part of a short line railroad that maintains its trackage to 40 mph (64 km/h) standards.
