Currently, 58.7% of the 74,408 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 30.9%, renter occupied; and 10.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 73,229 housing units in the area and 9.4% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.49%. Median home value in the area is \$247,920, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.04% annually to \$287,980.
