

THE MONTGOMERY + ALDRIDGE BUILDING is a

24,468-square-foot adaptive reuse historic building located in Durham's Central Park District. Roney Street first began as a residential street, but as the warehouse district began to develop in the 1930s, housing was demolished to construct warehouse and light industrial uses. 320 Roney Street was part of this transformation, built between 1925 and 1937. In 1937, it was used by the WP Henry Company as a tobacco warehouse. By the 1950s, Montgomery Aldridge used the property as a tire warehouse. Today, Roney Street is surrounded by vibrant Downtown Durham, with restaurants, retail, entertainment and housing nearby.

Building features include:

- High ceilings
- Wood columns and beams
- Skylights
- Flooring concrete on first floor, hardwood on second floor
- Deck parking available across the street with a parking ratio of 3.0/1,000 (additional fee)
- Rental rate \$32.00/rsf, Full Service

Formerly home to some of the nation's largest tobacco manufacturers, Downtown Durham is in the midst of a renaissance with former manufacturing plants being converted to modern, edgy commercial space. Transformative projects over the last decade have brought a critical mass of people to Downtown Durham to work, live and visit. Since 2000, investment in the CBD has totaled more than \$1.1 billion. More than 1,900 residential units have been completed since 2012, and another 1,880 units are underway or proposed. Adaptive re-use projects at the historic American Tobacco Campus and surrounding areas have served as a magnet for a wide array of tenants. Downtown Durham has become a hotbed for entrepreneurs with more than 100 startups within a onemile radius of the CBD. Located in the American Tobacco District, the American Underground was one of the region's first tech hubs for entrepreneurs, offering office and co-working space. It's one of just seven Google for Entrepreneurs Tech Hubs in North America, offering unique access to Google and its products.



AMENITIES

Downtown Durham offers an array of cultural and entertainment options. Home to the Durham Bulls, the Triple-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays, the Durham Bulls Athletic Park seats 10,000 and draws more than 540,000 attendees each season. Constructed in 2008, the Durham Performing Arts Center consistently ranks among the top five venues in the nation in box office sales. Durham has been called the Tastiest Town in the South by Southern Living Magazine due to its eclectic mix of local restaurants, many of which are located in the CBD.







Downtown Durham is made up of seven unique subdistricts that can be easily explored by foot or on the Bull City Connector, a bus route connecting downtown and Duke University. THE **MONTGOMERY + ALDRIDGE BUILDING** is located within the Central Park District, which encompasses Durham Central Park and where Foster Street and Rigsbee Avenue meet Geer Street. The park itself encompasses five acres, includes three gardens, and is the setting for the Durham Farmers' Market, concerts, movies, food truck rodeos and weddings. This area is a hotbed for live entertainment, bars and restaurants. Numerous opportunities for shopping and fitness are conveniently located just steps away.
