The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 60.9 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The five-year projection of households is 33,193, a change of 0.93% annually from the current year total. Average household size is currently 2.74, compared to 2.75 in the year 2020. The number of families in the current year is 23,537 in the specified area.

Current median household income is \$71,866 in the area, compared to \$72,603 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$80,699 in five years, compared to \$82,410 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$100,724 in this area, compared to \$107,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$113,905 in five years, compared to \$122,048 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$36,795 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$41,310. The per capita income is projected to be \$41,928 in five years, compared to \$47,525 for all U.S. households

Currently, 74.6% of the 34,307 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 17.8%, renter occupied; and 7.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 32,571 housing units in the area and 7.0% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.61%. Median home value in the area is \$228,504, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.96% annually to \$264,391.

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
