



Currently, 63.1% of the 145,449 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 25.0%, renter occupied; and 11.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 143,672 housing units in the area - 65.9% owner occupied, 23.9% renter occupied, and 10,3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.55%. Median home value in the area is \$105,429, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.29% annually to \$123,931.




Traffic Count Map - Close Up
