Currently, 48.7% of the 28,289 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 38.3%, renter occupied; and 13.0% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 27,967 housing units in the area - 53.3% owner occupied, 37.6% renter occupied, and 9.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.51%. Median home value in the area is \$114,126, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.76% annually to \$130,744.
