

Currently, 72.1% of the 50,323 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 21.4%, renter occupied; and 6.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 44,955 housing units in the area - 73.8% owner occupied, 20.2% renter occupied, and 6.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.54%. Median home value in the area is \$180,074, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.00% annually to \$209,143.
