Currently, 44.3% of the 66,554 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 43.1%, renter occupied; and 12.6% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 64,824 housing units in the area - 48.4% owner occupied, 42.1% renter occupied, and 9.5% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.18%. Median home value in the area is \$176,481, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.90% annually to \$193,902.
