

Currently, 64.5% of the 143,507 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 28.0%, renter occupied; and 7.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.7% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 140,729 housing units in the area - 66.2% owner occupied, 26.8% renter occupied, and 7.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.87%. Median home value in the area is \$141,255, compared to a median home value of \$200,006 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.68% annually to \$169,224.




Traffic Count Map - Close Up
