

Greater Cincinnati's newest,
best development and economic
opportunity. The Uptown Innovation
Corridor is located in Uptown
Cincinnati, approximately one-mile
north of the heart of downtown
Cincinnati. The corridor is centered
on the new I-71 interchange at Martin

Luther King Jr. Drive, and extends north and south along MLK and Reading Road to link with the five Uptown anchor institutions: The University of Cincinnati, UC Health, Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center, TriHealth and the Cincinnati Zoo & Botanical Garden.

- 5 anchor institutions located in the five surrounding neighborhoods
- 100+ properties acquired for corridor development
- \$25M invested in property acquisitions



New I-71 Interchange and Uptown Cincinnati

The new Interstate-71 Interchange at Martin Luther King Drive provides immediate access to the Uptown Gateway development.


Located at the front door of the \$80 million interchange, Uptown Gateway will be a landmark on Interstate-71 and an anchor to the Uptown Innovation Corridor.

Anchored by nationally top-rated hospitals, the greenest zoo in America and a world-class university, Uptown Cincinnati has the fastestgrowing economy in the region while maintaining a walkable area that 45,000 people call home. Located just one mile north of downtown, Uptown has a total employment impact of over 84,000 jobs, with 52,000 of those employees working within the five Uptown neighborhoods of Avondale, Clifton, Corryville, CUF and Mt. Auburn.

Uptown Cincinnati infuses \$11.6 billion annually into the regional economy and is where world changing breakthroughs and discoveries take place.

Uptown Consortium, Inc.

The Uptown Consortium, Inc. (UCI), was founded in 2004 by the leaders of Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center, Cincinnati Zoo & Botanical Garden, TriHealth, The University of Cincinnati and UC Health (formerly Health Alliance of Greater Cincinnati).


With Uptown Cincinnati, UCI brings local neighborhood, civic and institutional leaders together to advance economic development, transportation, community inclusion and public/private partnerships. To date, UCI's efforts have secured more than \$400 million in redevelopment, new construction and neighborhood improvements in Uptown Cincinnati.

Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center

Cincinnati Children's is the largest pediatric research facility in the country with over 1 million square feet of dedicated research space. Cincinnati Children's scientists are conducting breakthrough research to improve care for children. Cincinnati Children's is annually ranked as one of the top children's hospitals in the country, currently #3 in US News Hospital Rankings.

The Cincinnati Zoo and Botanical Garden

The Cincinnati Zoo and Botanical Garden is the second-oldest zoo in the United States and is perennially ranked as one of the top zoos in the country. The Center for Conservation and Research of Endangered Wildlife (CREW) and the Cincinnati Zoo's globally recognized breeding program saves species through science.



TriHealth

Through Good Samaritan Hospital and multiple sites of care, TriHealth provides a wide range of clinical, educational, preventive and social programs to the Uptown area. TriHealth is the fourth largest employer in Cincinnati, with approximately 11,500 team members.

The University of Cincinnati

UC has been called a "research heavy-weight" and "one of America's top public research universities." The University has nearly 200 years of history as a research pioneer. UC is classified as a "very high" research university by the Carnegie Commission and is consistently ranked as one of America's top public research universities for expenditures according to the National Science Foundation.

UC Health

UC Health has a rich history in medical discovery and innovation and is accredited to conduct clinical research by the Association for the Accreditation of Human Research Protection Programs (AAHRPP). Researchers routinely conduct industry, investigator-initiated and National Institutes of Health (NIH) sponsored clinical trials (phase I-IV) in nearly all therapeutic areas.
