### Overview

@Highland campus is a unique new mixed use office development integrating natural features with sleek, progressive architecture making a bold statement in the heart of South Baton Rouge. 
Building 1 is a dynamic architectural design approximately 52,000rsf with rich views of the Swamp along a boardwalk. The Class A building will feature secure, restricted access, LED lighting, and next generation technology features. Work amenities to include high speed, redundant internet providers, VOIP phone systems, monitored access, and both covered and outdoor ground level parking. Recreational amenities to include an outdoor relaxation deck, boutique restaurant, outdoor recreational areas, and a future link to the Bluebonnet Swamp walking trail system.






