



### THE CABLE HOUSE

Located at 2245 Gilbert Avenue in Cincinnati, Ohio, this 50,000 sf building includes unique historical features throughout. High ceilings and a sizable atrium provide an abundance of natural light, bouncing off walls of exposed brick and laid cobblestone in between the original oak structural beams.

#### A Crucial Component of Cincinnati's history...

In 1870, entrepreneur George Kerper constructed the second largest cable line in Cincinnati. Soon to become the Mt. Adams & Eden Park Railway, this operation ran until late 1898.


By 1950, The Cable House was renovated into unique office space, just minutes from downtown.






