## History of the Jungclaus Mill





The Jungclaus Mill was originally established as the Capitol City Planning Mill shortly after the Civil War. In 1895, William P. Jungclaus, a German immigrant and the foremost general contractor in Indianapolis, purchased the operation.

The William P. Jungclaus Company would go on to build and furnish the millwork for many of the most prominent landmarks in Indianapolis, including the Indiana Theater, the Columbia Club, the Circle Tower, and the Coca-Cola Bottling Plant.

The woodworking operation continued into the 1960s when it was shuttered. The construction company, now called Jungclaus-Campbell, turned its focus to the industrial and educational markets.

The upstairs of the old Mill sat largely untouched for over 50 years, complete with all its machinery. Many of these tools were originally powered by steam.

Still the home of Jungclaus-Campbell, the current, sixth-generation ownership decided in 2020 to adapt the historic properties into a mixed-used development known as the Jungclaus Mill.
