An example of this would be that at the onset of the COVID-19 crisis, it gave all of the store employees a \$3 per hour increase in wage, and donated all April profits to medical first responders on the front lines (see article here).





Location Overview



SANDY, a city in Salt Lake County Utah, is part of the Salt Lake City metropolitan area. With an estimated population of 96,901 residents, it is the state's sixth-largest city. Sandy also regularly ranks as one of the nation's safest cities. It educates more than 34,000 students and secured a \$283 million bond last fall to fund renovations for several existing schools and the construction of a new elementary school.

Sandy residents can take advantage of numerous shopping areas, as well as a new development dubbed The Cairns; intended as an anchor for the city's downtown, it includes luxury housing, performing arts theaters, and more.

SALT LAKE CITY is nestled along the foothills of the Rocky Mountains overlooking the largest inland lake in the western United States. Salt Lake City is situated within a 5-hour drive to 5 national parks: Zion National Park, Bryce Canyon National Park, Arches National Park, Canyonlands National Park and Capitol Reef National Park. More than 370 flights depart daily to 99 nonstop destinations, serving over 24.5 million passengers annually. The airport is currently undergoing a \$3.6 billion renovation and expansion to accommodate expected travel increases.

While the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints is headquartered in the city, with about 50% of residents identifying as Mormon, Salt Lake City is an ethnically and religiously diverse city. Since the completion of the transcontinental railroad in 1869, Salt Lake has been "The Crossroads of the West" and today, more than 120 languages are spoken among the city's population.
