


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CARMEL DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

Situated in the heart of Carmel's Civic Center and on the south edge of the Carmel City Center and The Center for the Performing Arts, this site is steps from the Monon Trail as well as the Gazebo, where summer concerts take place weekly.

Projects to the immediate north include Carmel City Center, a 1 million SF, mixed-use development featuring luxurious residences, specialty retail, unique dining, and premier office space, including a new \$13.9M parking garage with 580 spaces. To the south is the new Proscenium project, featuring nearly 400,000 SF of residential, retail, and office space and a 449-space underground parking garage.

Finally, Carmel has completed a transformation of Range Line Road to create a pedestrian-friendly boulevard, as well as the widening and beautification of the Monon Trail.
