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Preliminary Intersection Design

Planned Improvements

The project improvements will extend approximately 900 feet along each leg of the intersection. Key project elements include:

- Adding left turn lanes to provide a total of two left turn lanes in each direction.
- Constructing dedicated right turn lanes in all directions.
- Maintaining two through lanes in each direction.
- Constructing raised medians.
- New pavement and lane striping.
- Reconstructing and and upgrading city waterlines.
- Relocating underground and overhead utilities.

- Modifying driveways to accommodate the widened roadway.
- Relocating sidewalks, curbs and gutters.
- Providing bicycle lanes in each direction.
- Adding bus bays.
- Installing new street lighting.
- Installing new traffic signals and connecting them
 with adjacent traffic signals.
