INDIANA'S SHOVEL READY PROGRAM

Administered by the Indiana Economic Development Corporation, the Shovel Ready Program involves a team of representatives from that agency, the Governor's Office, Indiana Department of Natural Resources, Indiana Department of Environmental Management, Indiana Department of Transportation, Indiana State Department of Health, Indiana State Department of Agriculture and the Indiana State Department of Homeland Security.

To earn the Shovel Ready designation, sites must meet these ten key requirements that allow development to happen more quickly with far less red tape:

- Already meet all local government requirements, demonstrating support from local officials and assuring companies of a smooth process.
- Prove that clear title has been verified through a 50-year search, ensuring a quick closing.
- Boundaries and infrastructure must be fully mapped, allowing site design to begin immediately.
- Have a current Phase I Environmental Site Assessment that identifies wetlands.
- Complete the wetland delineation study and identify impact on waters.
- Water and wastewater service must already be available in sufficient capacity, allowing for immediate connections.

Transportation infrastructure maps and impact studies are complete, verifying that streets, roads, highways and rail service have sufficient capacity.

- Electrical service is sufficient to meet business needs.
- Natural gas service has adequate capacity to meet business needs.
- High-speed communication is already available at the site, with sufficient capacity.
