





## A RETAIL CORRIDOR

New luxury residential towers, hotels, and office developments transformed the Columbus Circle neighborhood, attracting affluent residents and tourists to Manhattan's newest retail corridor. The opportunity-rich area boasts \$1.65 billion in retail sales and is home to some of Manhattan's most iconic shopping destinations and innovative retail concepts.

#### NORDSTROM

The **367,000 SF Nordstrom flagship store** anchors 57th Street and Columbus Circle. The store represents Nordstrom's largest single-project investment and offers unique product categories and services, along with curated experiences and dining options.

#### BERGDORF GOODMAN

The iconic New York department store attracts **over 160,000 visitors per month**.

#### THE SHOPS AT COLUMBUS CIRCLE

Offers 364,000 SF of world-class restaurants, lounges, and 50-plus retail stores, which attract more than **16 million visitors per year**.


