Top Industries

The economy of Mentor, OH employs **25,000 people**. The largest industries in Mentor, OH are *Manufacturing* (4,499 people), *Health Care & Social Assistance* (3,853 people), and *Retail Trade* (2,696 people), and the highest paying industries are *Utilities* (\$87,321), *Public Administration* (\$61,423), and *Finance & Insurance* (\$61,265).¹

Cost of Living

The retail sector in Mentor is one of the strongest in the state, and manufacturing is also a prominent industry. Families take home on average \$69,902, certainly not bad in an area where the average cost of homes is \$167,200 and rent goes for \$886, both below national.²
