


First Floor Plan

Second Floor Plan



Basement Floor Plan





Downtown Omaha









Property History

History of the United States Army Quartermaster Corps

The United States Army Quartermaster Corps is a Sustainment (formerly combat service support or CCS) branch of the United States Army. It was also one of three U.S. Army logistics branches, the others being the Transitions Corps and the Ordnance Corps. The Quartermaster Corps is the U.S. Army's oldest logistics branch established on June 16, 1775. On that date, the Second Continental Congress passed a resolution providing for "one Quartermaster General of the grand army and a deputy, under him, for the separate army." From 1775 to 1912, this organization was known as the Quartermaster Department. In 1912, Congress consolidated the former subsistence, pay and Quartermaster departments to create the Quartermaster Corps. Quartermaster units and soldiers have served in every U.S. military operation from the Revolutionary War to current operations in Iraq (Operation Iraqi Freedom) and Afghanistan (Operation Enduring Freedom).

Quartermaster detachments, companies and battalions are normally assigned to corps or higher-level commands. Divisions and smaller units have multifunctional support battalions which combine functional areas from the Army Transportation Service Department, Army Quartermaster Corps, Army Ordnance Corps and the Army Medical Service Department. Quartermaster organizations include field service, general supply, petroleum supply and petroleum pipeline, aerial delivery (rigger), water and mortuary affairs units. Most are company level except petroleum and water, which have battalion and group level units.
