


## DESIGN



#### **DEEP ELLUM HISTORY**

Deep Ellum is a birthplace of American music, with its origins dating back to post-Civil War era America. Artists like Blind Lemon Jefferson and Huddie "Ledbelly" Ledbetter called Deep Ellum home. Robert Johnson, The Godfather of American Blues and Jazz, recorded some of his only known recordings at Warner Bros Studios in 1937, just three quarters of a mile from 2920 Taylor.

with stainless steel roll door garage, motion detected halogen flood lights in the front and back patio, security system, private parking spaces, and mail slot round out the exterior features of the building.


