Currently, 64.9% of the 32,400 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 25.6%, renter occupied; and 9.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 29,335 housing units in the area - 68.3% owner occupied, 25.5% renter occupied, and 6.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 4.52%. Median home value in the area is \$186,607, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.58% annually to \$201,835.
