














CULTURE





Midtown is home to Phoenix's Museum District. The Phoenix Art Museum, the world renowned Heard Museum and numerous other galleries provide unique exhibitions to the community. Midtown also features The Phoenix Opera, and is minutes away from Arizona's largest professional sports and concert event stadiums. Midtown Phoenix's many historical neighborhoods and parks offer lush greenery that has matured into an urban oasis amidst the bustling city. With their bike paths, fishing lakes, dog parks and walking trails, Midtown's parks are ideal for maintaining an active lifestyle. Midtown offers several public gardens and farmers' markets and many festivals, street fairs and cultural events are scheduled throughout the year. On the first Friday of each month, the art galleries of Roosevelt Row are featured in one of the nation's largest self-guided art walks. "First Friday" brings the community together to enjoy food trucks, live entertainment and, of course, art.







Midtown is in the midst of an urban renewal movement that is transforming the area into a 24-hour live/work/play environment. The repositioning of existing structures and development of new projects into a multitude of vibrant new restaurants, offices, luxury residential communities and retailers, add to the appeal for employers and residents in the area. For weekend getaways, all major freeways are within only a few minutes from Midtown and Sky Harbor International Airport is less than 15 minutes away.
