The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 70.5 in the identified area, compared to 72.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

The number of families in the current year is 44,622 in the specified area.

Currently, 54.9% of the 85,706 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 34.4%, renter occupied; and 10.7% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 84,402 housing units in the area and 9.7% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.47%. Median home value in the area is \$238,375, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.11% annually to \$277,864.

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
