SOPHISTICATED DESIGN

Set in the heart of the lively and energetic NoMa business district, 1050 First Street at Sentinel Square stands out with appealing architecture and a luminous presence along this noted corridor. The tower's facade is articulated in a striking composition of glass curtain wall, stainless steel, precast concrete, black granite, and ribbon windows. Extensive landscaping and an inviting courtyard complement the building's engaging exterior. Inside, an elegant two-story lobby welcomes visitors with premium accents and finishes, including Jerusalem Gold marble and louvered millwork panels.



SUSTAINABLE AND SECURE

Sentinel Square is one of Washington, D.C.'s premier office environments, already home to a host of federal agencies including: U.S. Customs and Border Protection, Department of Education, Federal Election Commission, Department of Homeland Security, U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, and U.S. Parole Commission. A thoughtful, integrated approach to the architecture and landscape design is reflected throughout this signature, Class A office setting. The second of four buildings planned for the development, 1050 First Street at Sentinel Square, features nearly 280,000 square feet of flexible, highly efficient space. The building is designed to achieve an ENERGYSTAR® designation and is registered under the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED® for Core & Shell™ with a certification goal of LEED Silver. The structure is capable of meeting advanced security and force-protection needs, with blast-resistant glass, progressive-collapse avoidance, and space for a host of secure access control measures.



EXCEPTIONAL ACCESS

Tenants of 1050 First Street at Sentinel Square enjoy a host of options for a streamlined commute, including the availability of four levels of below-grade parking. Union Station, just a few blocks away, provides quick access to MARC and VRE trains, AMTRAK, Metro bus and rail lines, and the new DC Streetcar. The Metropolitan Branch Trail is close by, and Union Station also offers the popular new Bikestation, with secure parking and services for cyclists. Several major thoroughfares, including I-395 and Route 50, are in close proximity to the site, and Reagan National Airport is just a few minutes away.
