

HISTORICAL 2,113 SF OFFICE BUILDING IN HAWAII CHINATOWN HISTORIC DISTRICT NOW AVAILABLE FOR LEASE



OCATED ON THE CORNER OF MERCHANT AND NU'UANU STREET IN THE HONOLULU CHINATOWN DISTRICT, 902 NU'UANU AVENUE (THE T.R. FOSTER BUILDING) IS A HISTORICAL TWO-STORY, BRICK COM-MERCIAL BUILDING, ORIGINALLY BUILT TO SERVE AS A SHIPPING WAREHOUSE IN 1891. SINCE, IT HAS ACQUIRED A DIVERSE TENANT BASE AS A MIXED BUSINESS USE PROPERTY. SHIPPING COMPANIES, BARS, RESTAURANTS, AS WELL AS OFFICE SPACES HAVE ALL CALLED THE T.R. FOSTER BUILDING HOME. TODAY, THE GROUND FLOOR OF THIS UNIQUE BUILDING IS OCCUPIED BY A POPULAR BAR/RESTAU-RANT OWNED BY THE CO-FOUNDER OF JJ DOLAN'S.





T.R. FOSTER BUILDING 1891 902 NU UANU AVENUE AND 6 2 10 MARIN STREET


AT AGE 22. SHIPWRIGHT THOMAS R. FUSTER MOVED FROM RHODE ISLAND, TO HAWAIT TU TRY SHIPBUILDING IN, THE PACIFIC. HE FOUND FORTUNE, ADVENTURE AND THELOVE OF HIS LIFE.

IN 1861, HE MET AND MARRIED MAR. ELIZABETH MIKAHALA ROBINSON. THE ECDEST DAUGHTER OF SHIPBUILDER JAMES ROBINSON. FOSTER LED THE SALVAGE OF THE SAROUE LIBEL E OFF WAKE ISLAND IN 1867. HE FOUNDED INTER-ISLAND STEAMINAVIGATION COMPANY (LATER TO BECOME RAWAIIAN AIRLINES) AND PURCHASED THE ESTATE OF BUTANIST WILLIAM HILLEBRAND, WHICH WAS LATER BEQUEARHED TO THE CITY OF HONOLULU AS FOSTER DOTANICAL CARDEN AT THE DEATH OF HIS WIFE, MARY E. FOSTER IN 1920. HE PLANNED AND BRO JOHT ABOUT THE PURCHASE OF THE ENTIRE KARAMA VALLEY FOR HIS WHE FOR HER COUNTRY ROMS.

FOSTER DIED IN 1880 INO LEARS DATER, MS SUCCESSORS ERECTED THIS OUT DING INSERIORD WITH T.A. FOSTER'S NAME IN HIS MEMORY.








HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE A PART OF HAWAII'S HISTORY & ECONOMY SINCE 1891

The T.R. Foster Building has stood on the corner of Nu'uanu and Merchant streets on O'ahu since 1891. While many of the neighboring buildings and surrounding roads have changed over time, this property continues as one of downtown Honolulu's landmark buildings.

The building was designed in the Italianate style and is characterized by original parapet, cornice, pilasters, and second floor facade. At the top of the building is a tower and tympanum embossed with T. R. Foster and the year the building was erected. The building also has a bell-tower, parapets and decorative columns. Other notable Oʻahu buildings built in this style include the Mendoca Block Building and the neighboring Royal Saloon Building.

The T. R. Foster Building was commissioned by the Inter-Island Steamship Navigation Company in 1891. The two-story brick building stands as a memorial to Thomas R. Foster, the founder of the steamship company. The Inter-Island Steamship Navigation Company eventually expanded to airship travel and became known as Inter-Island Airways in 1928. The name changed to Hawaiian Airlines in 1941.

The T. R. Foster Building, was constructed in 1891 by Thomas R. Foster, one of the founders of the Inter-Island Steam Navigation Company which, in 1941, became Hawaiian Airlines. Located at 902 Nu'uanu Avenue, the Italianate-style building has white stucco pilasters, balustrade, and cornice that are similar to the Royal Saloon Building across the street.



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
