









NEIGHBORHOOD OVERVIEW

Montlake is a charming, affluent urban neighborhood bounded by the Montlake Cut and the University of Washington to the north, the Washington Park Arboretum to the east, Eastlake to its west and Capitol Hill on its south side. It's proximity to the University of Washington, Interstate 5 and the 520 bridge make it convenient and easily accessible from surrounding areas and the Eastside. Within walking distance to University of Washington Light Rail Station. Neighborhood businesses include the recently opened Oxbow, Fuel Coffee, Cafe Lago, Salon Filament, Montlake Bike Shop, and Montlake Branch of The Seattle Public Library.


PROPERTY HIGHLIGHTS

- Rare free-standing brick building in the charming Montlake neighborhood, located just south of the University of Washington campus and Husky Stadium
