



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Isla Vista

The Subject Portfolio is situated in the ideal college beach community of Isla Vista, an unincorporated area located in South Santa Barbara County and part of the greater Santa Barbara metro area. Roughly 10 miles west of the city of Santa Barbara, Isla Vista is bounded by Goleta to the north, the University of California Santa Barbara to the east, UCSB faculty housing to the west and the Pacific Ocean to the south.

The community primarily consists of multi-family and single-family residences and serves largely as a student housing base for UCSB. With a good base of recreational amenities, Isla Vista's downtown core includes a central park, food and beverage establishments and retail services and markets, all geared toward students. At just 1.8 sq. miles, the community is very bike friendly, and it is also serviced by Santa Barbara's Regional Transit Authority bus line.

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University of California Santa Barbara

A short distance north of Santa Barbara is the University of California, Santa Barbara. The sprawling campus is situated on 1,055 acres along the pristine California coastline about 100 miles northwest of Los Angeles.

Newsweek has named UCSB one of the country's "hottest colleges" twice in the past decade, and U.S. News and World Report ranks UCSB number 10 among all public universities.
